

## PREFACE

The Handbook of Statistics on the Indian Economy is a comprehensive database of macroeconomic and financial information, which has been made available in the public domain since 1998. It is also simultaneously released in electronic form on the “Database on Indian Economy (DBIE): the Reserve Bank’s Data Warehouse (<https://dbie.rbi.org.in>)”, where it is updated on a regular basis.

2. The publication for the year 2016-17 is the nineteenth in the series. It contains 248 statistical tables, covering time series on a wide range of economic and financial indicators pertaining to national income aggregates, output, prices, money, banking, financial markets, public finances, foreign trade, balance of payments and select socio-economic indicators, at varying frequencies.
