## List of Terrorist Individuals/ Organisations under UNSCR 1267(1999),1822(2008) and 1989(2011) on Taliban/AI-Qaida Organisation

Please refer to our <u>circular letter DBOD. AML No. 1106 /14.06.001/2011-12 dated July</u> <u>20, 2011</u>. We have since received from Government of India (Ministry of External Affairs) copies of notes forwarded by the Chairman of UN Security Council's 1267 Committee (copy enclosed) regarding changes made in the Consolidated List of Individuals and entities linked to Al-Qaida, as detailed below:

- 1. Note dated July 29, 2011 (Annex I)
- 2. Note dated August 12, 2011 (Annex II)
- 3. Note dated August 22, 2011(Annex III)

2. Banks/All India Financial Institutions are required to update the consolidated list of individuals/entities as circulated by Reserve Bank and before opening any new account, it should be ensured that the name/s of the proposed customer does not appear in the list. Further, banks should scan all existing accounts to ensure that no account is held by or linked to any of the entities or individuals included in the list.

3. Banks are advised to strictly follow the procedure laid down in the UAPA Order dated August 27, 2009 enclosed to our <u>circular DBOD.AML.BC. No.</u> <u>44/14.01.001/2009-10 dated September 17, 2009</u> and ensure meticulous compliance to the Order issued by the Government.

4. As far as freezing of funds, financial assets or economic resources or related services held in the form of bank accounts of the designated individuals/entities are concerned, action should be taken as detailed in paragraph 6 of the circular dated September 17, 2009, mentioned above.
