RBI cancels licence of The Praja Co-operative Urban Bank Ltd.

The Reserve Bank of India has cancelled the licence granted to The Praja Cooperative Urban Bank Ltd., Secunderabad, Ranga Reddy Dist. (Andhra Pradesh) to carry on banking business. The bank is precluded from transacting the business of `banking' as defined in the Banking Regulation Act, 1949 (As applicable to Co-operative Societies) and it will not be in order for it, among other things, to accept deposits from public and allow withdrawals by cheque, draft, order or otherwise.
