RBI cancels licence of the Sri Mouneshwar Cooperative Bank Ltd., Gulbarga, Karnataka

June 4, 2003

The Reserve Bank of India has cancelled the licence of Sri Mouneshwar Cooperative Bank Ltd., Gulbarga, Karnataka to carry on banking business. The bank is precluded from transacting the business of 'banking' as defined in the Banking Regulation Act, 1949 (As applicable to Co-operative Societies) and it will not be in order for it, among other things, to accept deposits from public and allow withdrawals by cheque, draft, order or otherwise.

The Reserve Bank has cancelled the licence under Section 22 of the Banking regulation Act, 1949 (as applicable to Co-operative Societies).
