RBI cancels licence of Solapur Zilla Mahila Shakari Bank Ltd.

The bank is precluded from transacting the business of 'banking' as defined in the Banking Regulation Act, 1949 (as applicable to Co-operative Societies) and prohibited it among other thing, from accepting deposits from the public and allow withdrawals by cheque, draft, order or otherwise.
