Sectoral Deployment of Bank Credit – February 2017

Data on sectoral deployment of bank credit collected on a monthly basis from select 46 scheduled commercial banks, accounting for about 95 per cent of the total non-food credit deployed by all scheduled commercial banks, for the month of February 2017 are set out in Statements I and II. These data are also available in the Real-Time Handbook of Statistics on the Indian Economy (https://dbie.rbi.org.in).

Highlights of the sectoral deployment of bank credit are given below:

- On a year-on-year (y-o-y) basis, non-food bank credit increased by 3.3 per cent in February 2017 as compared with an increase of 9.9 per cent in February 2016.
- Credit to agriculture and allied activities increased by 9.0 per cent in February 2017 as compared with an increase of 13.5 per cent in February 2016.
- Credit to industry contracted by 5.2 per cent in February 2017 in contrast with an increase of 5.4 per cent in February 2016. Credit growth to major subsectors such as 'infrastructure', 'food processing', 'basic metal & metal products' and 'textiles' decelerated/contracted. However, credit growth to 'petroleum, coal products & nuclear fuels', 'wood & wood products', 'cement & cement products', 'vehicles, vehicle parts & transport equipment' and 'construction' accelerated.
- Credit to the services sector increased by 7.7 per cent in February 2017 as compared with an increase of 8.6 per cent in February 2016.
- Personal loans increased by 12.0 per cent in February 2017 as compared with an increase of 19.2 per cent in February 2016.

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
