3. Shri. Suresh Kumar K, Assistant Manager (Tech-Electrical), explained in detail the technicalities involved in the work and the item wise clarification of the schedule of quantity.

Rs.10,00,000/- per annum II. Rs.2,00,000/- per occurrence The rates quoted shall be inclusive of insurance.

Contractor was advised that the tender documents should be uploaded in e-Tendering portal well before the last date of bidding to avoid any last-minute errors/rush and also informed that the EMD for the work should preferably be transferred in the form of NEFT to the account provided in the Tender Document. The vendor was also advised that the bidding shall be entered by downloading the excel sheet uploaded by Reserve Bank of India in the MSTC portal. The item wise rates should be entered excluding GST.

6. Bidders shall note that, all the above clarifications provided by the Bank during the prebid meeting, along with details indicated in the Tender document shall form part of the Tender/Contract.
