Prospective authors interested to share their articles for the special edition are invited to share their perspectives on areas relevant to financial inclusion by the co-operative sector. There are no publication charges, and we pay an honorarium of Rs. 4000/- to the authors of papers which are selected for publishing in the journal. The papers may be submitted on or before 06:00 PM of July 31, 2025.

The length of the paper should be around 4000 to 7000 words typed in MS-Word, 1.5-spaced, justified in Arial 12 font. All figures, tables, footnotes, etc., should be properly placed and referenced. An abstract of about 150-200 words should be included with keywords and JEL classification. The first page of the manuscript should contain only the title of the paper and author(s) details. The main text including the abstract should commence from the second page for anonymity and no author information should be included in any part of the paper.

Papers after preliminary editorial screening and plagiarism check are subjected to double-blind peer review and revisions, if needed, before publication. The Flyer of the previous issues of the Journal are available in the CAB website for reference.
