Villagers were informed about Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima (PMJJBY) offering ₹2 lakh coverage at an annual premium of ₹436, Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima (PMSBY) providing ₹2 lakh accident insurance at ₹20 per year, Atal Pension Yojana (APY) with lifetime pensions of ₹1,000–₹5,000, zero-balance PMJDY accounts, direct

benefit transfers, and free KYC re-verification. Awareness was also created on digital fraud prevention, bank grievance resolution, and instant registration facilities including on-the-spot issuance of cards.

The camp saw participation from a large number of villagers, farmers, women's groups, youth, and bank customers, making it a successful initiative in promoting financial literacy and social security awareness.
