

Nominee receives Rs. 2 Lakh under PMJJBY insurance benefit in South dist

Agartala, August 25: Sujit Datta coming from Goburchara village under Hrishamukh R.D Blok has received a total of Rs. 2 lakh cheque of South Sonaichari Branch from Tripura Gramin Bank as nominee of the beneficiary namely Late Beauty Datta Majumder under the Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana (PMJJBY).

The yojana provides facility with a one-year renewable term life insurance cover of Rs. 2 lakh for a nominal annual premium of Rs. 436, for individuals aged 18 to 50 years with coverage continuing until the subscriber attains the age of 55 who hold

a savings bank account. The social sector development benefits schemes are really beneficial for the beneficiaries but the lack of awareness among people is the most important in this regard. Keeping it in mind the central government's directions are being implemented by the ongoing three-month state-wide campaign started from 1st July to be continued on September 30th this year focuses on Re-KYC, financial literacy, fraud awareness, and unclaimed deposit access. It is being coordinated by the Lead District Office, CFL team of Bagma Agri Producer Company Limited (BAPCL), banks, government departments, and PRI

members. In a significant step towards achieving Financial Inclusion and Social Security Scheme saturation in Tripura, two special camps were held today at Uttar Sonaichari GP of Hrishyamukh R.D.
