

RBI conducts Re-KYC, FIS camps

THE Reserve Bank of India's (RBI) Nagpur Regional Office, in collaboration with the State Bank of India and Bank of India, organised two special Financial Inclusion Saturation and re-KYC camps at Mansar and Mahadula Gram Panchayats in Ramtek block in the district recently.

At the heart of the initiative was facilitating re-KYC (Know Your Customer) updates to keep accounts active, secure, and compliant. Account holders were guided through simple update processes, either through self-declaration (in case of unchanged details) or by providing updated identity documents such as Aadhaar, Voter ID, NREGA Job Card, Driving License, or Passport, and digital re-KYC via Aadhaar OTP or Video-based Customer Identification Process (V-CIP) from home.

The camps saw a huge turnout of villagers.
