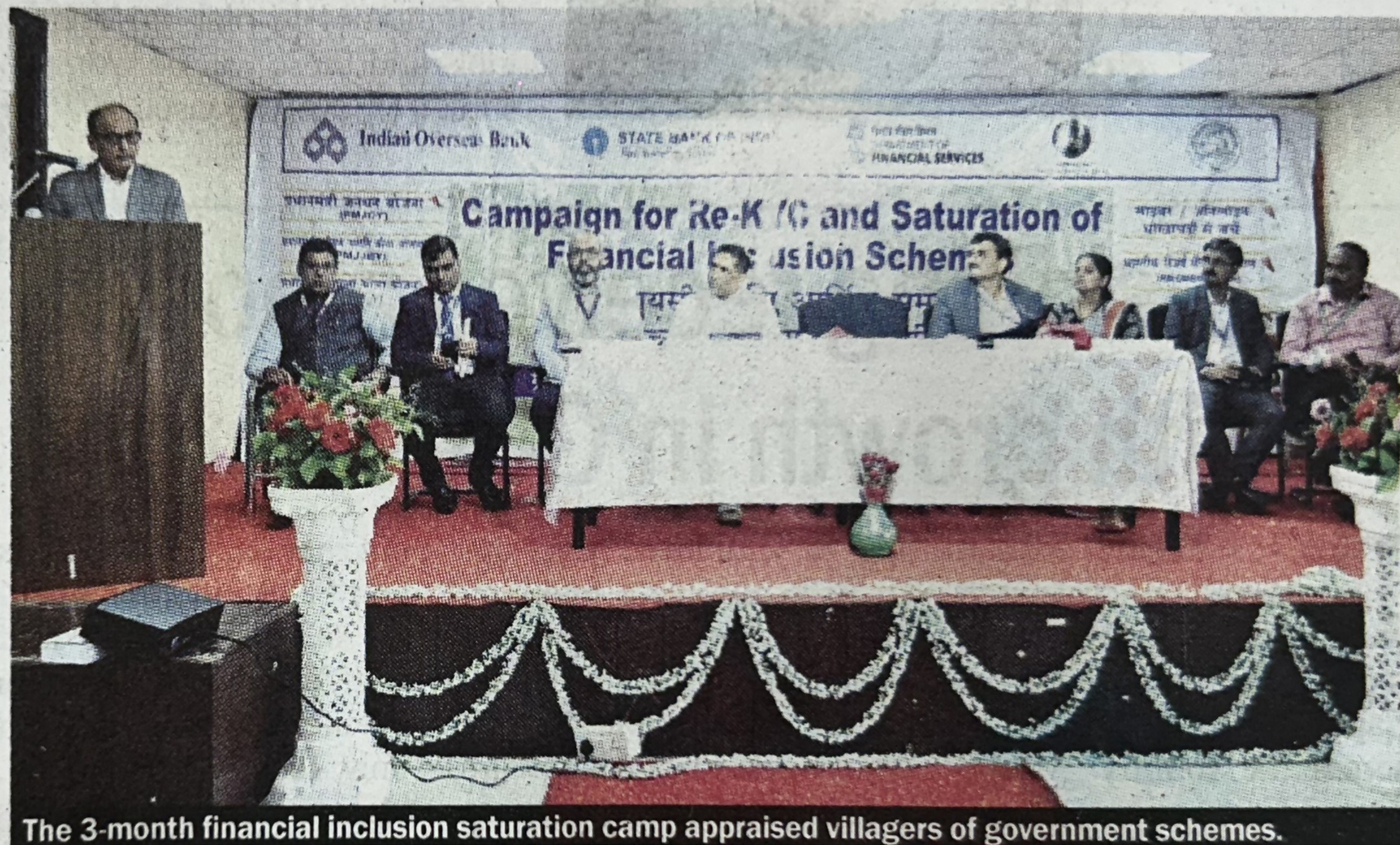


Financial inclusion saturation campaign held at Querim
